Selma Riverfront Multi-Use Historic Riverfront Walking and Bicycle Trail

AUTHORIZATION TO REQUEST PROPOSALS FOR
CONSTRUCTION, ENGINEERING, INSPECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a FY 2008 Transportation Enhancement Grant, Project Number STPTE-TE08(934) from the Alabama Department of Transportation which requires Construction, Engineering, Inspection services by a reputable firm that is QCI qualified, for monitoring of erosion control, traffic control, and concrete; *and*

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) requires bid advertisement for two consecutive weeks in the local newspaper and at least one week in a regional newspaper; *and*

WHEREAS, the cost for the professional services will be incurred via the Community Reinvestment Account.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:
